When flying, it is crucial to ensure that your portable battery does not exceed the maximum capacity of 100 watt-hours (Wh). If a power bank has a capacity between 100 and 160 Wh, ...

Spare Lithium Batteries: You can bring 2 to 8 spare lithium batteries in your carry-on, whether they are in equipment or protective cases. Power Banks: Up to 8 power banks are permitted in your carry-on, ...
