

Can I put oil cans in the kitchen cabinet

Drawer dividers (such as these adjustable Bamboo Drawer Organizers) are ideal if you want to store cans in kitchen cabinet drawers and need to prevent them from rolling around.

Store them in a cool, dry cabinet or cupboard, and as far away as possible from your stove. It might not be intuitive, but the absolute best place to store cooking oil is the refrigerator.

To describe a specific occurrence in the past, use *was/were able to* instead of *could*.
