What does a negative volt meter mean on a solar panel?

This measures across the terminals or wires of the solar panel. You must set the volt meter to read DC Volts. If there's a negative number displayed on the voltmeter then that means that the leads are pointing in the wrong direction. A minus sign indicates a negative charge.

How do you measure a solar panel polarity?

You can also use a volt meter to measure the voltage. This determines the solar panel's polarity. Even when inside a building, a simple voltage reading will reveal the polarity of a solar panel. Put the red positive meter lead on one side and the black negative lead on the other. This measures across the terminals or wires of the solar panel.
