How can local governments support solar installation?

Local governments can work with labor unions to provide opportunities for unionized workers to support solar deployment in their community. Some unions include trained solar installers and members that work directly on energy efficiency, building retrofits, solar site construction, and energy audits.

How can a local solar installation baseline be used?

Such data can be gathered from government departments tasked with solar permitting, the local utility, solar installers, the state energy office, and industry associations (e.g., the Solar Energy Industries Association). After an installation baseline has been developed, it can be used to establish realistic local solar targets.
