How much does Montenegro export?

In macroeconomic terms, Montenegro's total exported goods represent 3.8% of its overall Gross Domestic Product for 2023 (\$19 billion valued in Purchasing Power Parity US dollars). That 3.8% for exports to overall GDP in PPP for 2023 compares to 4.6% for 2022.

Where is electricity produced in Montenegro?

The majority of electricity in Montenegro is primarily produced at the Pljevlja coal-fired Thermal Power Plant and the Perucica and Piva Hydropower Plants. The core activities of the majority state-owned Electrical Power Company of Montenegro (EPCG) are electricity generation, transmission, distribution, and supply.
