A shared 40-foot container that once cost \$3,500 can now exceed \$6,000 during peak demand.

Why did shipping containers go out of business?

Factories slowed production, ports reduced staff, and tens of thousands of shipping containers sat idle. As consumer demand rebounded faster than anticipated--driven by stimulus spending and e-commerce--the demand for shipping containers surged beyond available supply.
