Can you sit on a solar panel?

Sitting on a solar panel would carry the same weight if you were to stand on them, so again it's not advised that you sit on a solar panel. This is unless the solar panel is specifically designed to withstand the weight of a human. This would include tempered glass and a reinforced frame. All of which would reduce the efficiency of the solar panel.

Is it safe to walk on solar panels?

In general, it's best not to walk on solar panels. If it's a must, take these precautions seriously. You might think it's safe to walk on solar panels, but think again. There's a chance of getting shocked by DC currents that are dangerous. So be careful out there. When you walk on solar panels, the glass can get scratched.

How do you walk on a solar panel?

One method used by most solar installers is to walk by stepping only on the metal frames of the PV modules. This does not cause any damage to the solar cells and, in most cases, no damage at all to the PV module. A second alternative used in the solar industry is using solar panel walking shoes (as seen in the figure above).
