Why did the EPA terminate a \$7 billion solar grant program?

The Environmental Protection Agency on Thursday terminated a \$7 billion grant program intended to help pay for residential solar projects for more than 900,000 lower-income U.S. households. This move is part of the Trump administration's efforts to hinder the nation's shift to cleaner energy.
