How much does electricity cost in Bulgaria?

The chart below displays the hourly electricity prices for Bulgaria. Bulgaria is 11.00 cents per kilowatt-hour(kWh). The pricing information displayed is sourced from ENTSO-E - the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity. All prices are originally in Central European Time (CET/CEST).

What is the main source of electricity in Bulgaria?

Nuclear power is another major contributor to Bulgaria's electricity supply. The Kozloduy Nuclear Power Plant, operational since the 1970s, is a key facility in this regard. Its output significantly reduces the country's reliance on imported energy sources, providing a stable and substantial amount of Bulgaria's electricity needs.
